

My layout is ready for print once I have checked...

- Page numbers are correct according to the “Article Assignment” sheet.
- Print date is correct
- New quotation
 - It is centered and fills the space appropriately (font size 10-14 pt)
 - No space between hyphen and the first name (-Albert Einstein, not - Albert Einstein).
- Check to see ALL advertisements are in layout according to the “Ad’s Spreadsheet”
- Check bylines
 - Spelling of names
 - Newspaper responsibilities (editor, guest writer, photographer, etc.)
- Photo credits
 - 7 pt font
 - Photo by _____
 - Photo courtesy of _____ (guest/borrowed picture)
 - Info courtesy of _____
- Captions
 - Italics
 - 9 pt
 - ALL pictures have one
- Photos ALWAYS have a 1pt box to outline picture (goes for graphics, charts, etc.)
- Body text
 - 10 pt
 - Times New Roman
 - NO OUTLINES
- Run spell check
 - edit→ spelling→ check spelling
- Gray box 10% transparency
- Rulers to align all text, pictures, advertisements, etc.
- Pulled quotes
 - Use quotation marks
 - Bold italics, font size: nothing unreasonably big
 - Hyphen followed by attribution (ex. –Courtney Baxter)
 - Double lines to frame it in
